Registration for K-8 will be done online (for the first time!) through FACTS Student Information System (which is different than FACTS Tuition Management).

Mrs. Davenport will host a meeting at 6pm THIS EVENING, February 24 to explain (among other things) the new reregistration procedures. At least one adult from each K-8 household should attend, so every family understands new procedures.
