### "Doing Our Part"

If you have any questions, please contact Mrs. Steinmetz in the office. Families must be current in their tuition to complete enrollment for the upcoming year. Please send in your completed reregistration papers (with the \$50/student registration fee) ASAP so we know to expect you—thank you!

### Tuition Assistance for the 2015-16 School Year

Application forms for the Fr. Bartone grant are now available in the school office. (Remember that you must have first applied for the Archdiocese's grant to be eligible for the Bartone grant, and that families receiving the "introductory" tuition rates are not eligible for this assistance.) Applications are due <u>May</u> 29.
