FINANCIAL AID FOR 2019-20

Application for the Archdiocesan Grant must be made online: to apply go to: https://online.factsmgt.com. You can log into your existing FACTS account. (or create a new one, if you don't already have one). You must be Catholic to be eligible for this grant.

Please note that you must also have your pastor's signature on the "Pastor's Signature Form" (which you'll find at the above address on the school website).

Archdiocesan grant applications need to be submitted and complete before the end of April.

Measles

You've probably heard in the news of measles outbreaks in nearby counties. Measles is a highly contagious and serious disease. In the event of an outbreak in a school, students not fully immunized will be excluded for at least 21 days after their last exposure.

The Health Department says that symptoms most often begin with a fever, runny nose and eyes, and cough. A red blotchy rash will develop 3-7 days after the fever starts: first on the face and gradually moving down the body.

The measles vaccine (MMR) is very effective: the recommended two doses are approximately 97% effective at preventing measles.





















