Dear School Students, Familias, and Reall.

With the current mostles outbreak in Southeastern Microgar growing quickly, and saveral meastes outbreaks nationalde, the St. Clair County Health Department (SCCHO) whild the to provide some information about this secous disease. SCCHO is committed to protecting the community from vicetno preventable diseases like meastes and follows guidelines catablished by the Microgan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS).

Meaning is a lightly contegious virus that lives in the noise and 8-rost muchs of an infected person; it is pussed to others by coughing and aneazing, as well as by contact with a contaminated surface or object. The meastes virus will live in the air and an objects for 2 hours, infecting 80% of unprotected people even after the 1 person has left the norm. Symptoms several about 7-14 they after exposure, but can take up to 21 days. The first sign of meastes is usually a high lever, atong with a runny noise, red eyes, cough and sore threat 3-5 days after these symptoms, a rash will appear that begins on the face and moves down to the neck, trunk, arms, legs, and first, "If symptoms of meastes develop, please do not visit your healthcare provider or emergency room without calling shead first, it is important that precautions are taken to prevent others from becoming exposed?"

There is no treatment for moustos, but there is a way to prevent in the combination measure, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccine. This safe and effective vectorie has been available since 1971. Children need two closes of MMR-one dosn at 12-15 months and another close at 4-6 years. Needs NPC adults should also be up to date on their MMR vaccination.

It is important to note than even one case of meastes in a daycare or school will prompt SCCHD to exclude all individuals, including stalf and volunteers, who are not protected from meastes either through vaccination or provious history of having that the discuss. This exclusion will last for 21 days after the test case has been identified, as that is thriving the it can take to devolop symptoms after exposure to the virus.

We understand the educational and practical challenges of students in saling school for skiveral weeks and therefore encourage all families to consider vaccination terformaccination becomes necessary as a disease control measure.
