You will need this to do ANY classroom or lunchroom volunteering.

When you go to a "PGC" workshop, please be sure to be on time, as the Archdiocese does not allow admittance to latecomers.

All volunteers working with children must have attended a "PGC" workshop. <u>Remember: you need to complete this</u> workshop in order to volunteer for field day or camp or to chaperone field trips.

FINANCIAL AID FOR 2019-20

We are fortunate in having local financial aid available (such as the Bartone grant). Applying for the Archdiocesan Grant <u>is required</u> before applying for any "local" assistance. (Note: you don't necessarily have to **receive** the Archdiocesan grant to apply for Bartone assistance, but you need to have applied for the AoD grant to be eligible for all other local help.) Get an application form for this "local" aid at the school office (they're due TOMORROW--May 31): there's a lot of help available: but you have to <u>APPLY</u>! (BEFORE THE WEEKEND!!)

Financial Aid.....

Important things to remember when you are applying for Holy Cross financial aid…

- you must have applied for the Archdiocese of Detroit's grant first;
- you can get the Holy Cross financial aid application at the school office;
- you must work your 12 "service credits" (and not opt to pay for them);
- you must attach a copy of your Archdiocesan grant application;
- 5. you must attach a copy of your 2018 US 1040 tax return; and
- <u>your application must be completed and in the school of</u>
 <u>fice by May 31</u>.
