Protecting God's Children Workshops

The Archdiocese of Detroit's "Protecting God's Children" workshop is held periodically throughout the Archdiocese. EVERY classroom or lunchroom volunteer or employee needs to have attended. To find a session that fits your schedule, go to www.virtus.org and select "First Time Registrant." Then choose "view list" of class sites, and choose "Detroit." Scroll through to find your session, then go back to the top of that page to create your login.

When attending a "PGC" workshop, be sure to be on time, as the Archdiocese does not allow latecomers to enter.

All volunteers working with children must have attended a "PGC" workshop.

Remember: you need to complete this workshop in order to volunteer for field day or camp or to chaperone field trips.

If you have recently attended a "PGC" workshop, please send a copy of your certificate to school ASAP so we have it on file--thank you!

SCRIP OFFICE is closed as long as school is.

COVID Impact

We hope you've all been enjoying this extra time with your children. Perhaps it's not what any of us would have chosen--but sometimes life doesn't offer us choices; so we roll with what we get. (grateful that it isn't worse) Thank you all for making distance learning work for your children as well as it has been.

As of now: we will return to school on April 13, when the Governor's "stay-at-home" order expires. (If that order is extended, we will adjust that return date accordingly.)

The Archdiocese of Detroit has assured us that its schools are not subject to the recent questions on the acceptability of distance learning, and that our students are on track to finish the year as planned.

Registration for 2020-21

(Look for the "early registration" discount! --noting all obligations for the current school year (including tuition, fees and service credits) must be completed to be eligible.) The packet also included financial aid information--it's time to apply for that, as well!

Archdiocesan Grants

Applications for tuition assistance from the Archdiocese of Detroit for 2020-21 are now being accepted.

To apply for the Archdiocesan grant: go to your FACTS account and look for "apply for tuition assistance". Application is done online, and there is a small fee. You will also need to print the "Pastor's Signature" page and get your (Archdiocese of Detroit parish) pastor's signature as part of your application. **Your application and all supporting paperwork must be complete and submitted by April 30** in order to qualify for tuition assistance from the Archdiocese of Detroit.

Please note that as of today we are NOT aware of an extension to the April 30 application deadline, so PLEASE BE SURE TO APPLY ASAP!

CORONAVIRUS

We continue to stay in daily contact with the Health Department, and are reviewing and updating our protocols and procedures.

The Health Department advises all to maintain cleanliness of frequently-touched surfaces (e.g. doorknobs, light switches, desks, keyboards, counter-tops, bathroom surfaces...). They also advise teaching and reviewing proper handwashing techniques and other ways of reducing disease transmission (e.g. coughing or sneezing into a tissue or elbow) with children.

When we are able to return to school: school policy requires students who have flu-like symptoms or a fever to remain away from school. Reducing a fever with medication does **not** eliminate the cause of the fever, and **the student must still stay away from school** until the fever is gone naturally.

We are lucky in already being set up for distance learning. With our Chrome-books and Google classroom / IXL work, online learning is already in place for our 1-8 students, and electronic (and other) communications are being planned for our Kindergartners to keep them learning, too.
