Science Fair!

Mrs. Wade's 5-8th grade science students are beginning to work on their science fair projects. As part of their projects, each student will choose a topic and create a hypothesis, then design and perform an experiment to test that hypothesis. The students check to see if the results of their experiment support their hypothesis. Then they present the experiment, including a research paper, on a display board for all to see.

(Students are welcome to create their own display boards. Some cardboard display boards are also available at the school office for \$3 each.)
