#### **Attention CMC Bus Riders:**

Looking ahead to the last days of school.....CMC will be dismissing early (11:10am) June 7-9 and at 10:40am on Friday, June 10. We will have regular school days June 7-9, and dismiss after awards are presented to students at about noon on Friday.

CMC buses will transport students as usual on the mornings of June 7-10.

To go home on June 7-9, the south bus will be here for Holy Cross riders at 2:50pm. However, the north bus will NOT return for Holy Cross riders those days.

For the ride home on Friday, June 10: bus riders may opt to leave Holy Cross at 10:40am, when the CMC buses leave.
