Protecting God's Children Workshops

Scroll through to find your session, then go back to the top of that page to create your login.

All volunteers working with children must have attended a "PGC" workshop. Remember: you need to complete this workshop in order to volunteer for field day or camp, or to chaperone field trips.

Friends of Holy Cross have provided for a total of four \$500 scholarships* for current Holy Cross students in grades K-8. Up to two awards will be made to applicants in grades K-4, and up to two to students in grades 5-8**.

To apply for the "Something Great" scholarship:

Students will write a composition on 'something great' that they are doing to help someone else this summer. Each student's grade level will be taken into consideration in the assessment of his/her entry/application; younger students especially are encouraged to include drawings in their work. (Only one entry per student, please.)

Students: please do NOT put your name on the front of your entry. Please complete and attach the bottom portion of this page to the back of your entry.

Entry / applications are due in the school office by 12 noon on Monday, July 11.

Awards will be announced in the Thursday, August 4 school newsletter.

*The award for a student receiving the "New to Catholic Schools" discounted tuition will be \$200.

**In the event an insufficient number of students applies in either age grouping, eligibility will be spread out among all applicants. If a winner's tuition is already paid, the award will be held as a credit towards camp or next year's tuition.
