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## **Definitions:**

\*Behavior - Injury or discomfort is based on how it is received, regardless of intent

**Intervention** - an age-appropriate and brief conversation about the child's behavior and choices. Student is informed their behavior/choices are inappropriate and why. For grades three through five, this intervention should include stating the hurtful/inappropriate behavior, stating the expectations, and the student listing alternate actions for the behavior/choice.

Reflective Recess - the student will spend recess time in an alternative location (classroom, office, etc.) reflecting on his/her behavior/choices. The student will complete a *Behavior Reflection*.
