#### Service Credits For 2020-21

Statements were mailed recently. Just a reminder that service credits (and payment for credits not worked) need to be completed by the end of April. Families on Plan A (paying for service credits) owed their final payment on April 1. All obligations must have been met to reregister for the next year.

#### **Registration for 2021-2**

To register, your registration paperwork must be completed and returned to the school office with the appropriate fees. Also, all prior years' tuition and other obligations must be satisfied in full before a family's registration is complete.






