Scroll through to find your session, then go back to the top of that page to create your login.

All volunteers working with children must have attended a "PGC" workshop. Remember: you need to complete this workshop in order to volunteer for field day or camp or to chaperone field trips.

Registration for 2020-21

Registration packets for the 2020-21 school year went home with your oldest "Crusader" in a blue folder in March. Registrations were due today for the "early registration discount," but that's being extended to tomorrow: **deliver vour** completed registration to school by tomorrow (9am-noon or 6-8pm) to be eligible for the "early" discount! Your application and all supporting paperwork must be complete and submitted by May 15 in order to qualify for tuition assistance from the Archdiocese of Detroit. Applying for this grant is required if you plan to apply for "local" tuition help, as well—PLEASE APPLY ASAP if you hope for any tuition assistance for 2020-21!

Distance Learning Info

We may not return to "in-school" classes before the end of this school year. However, that does not change our working online: and Mrs. Davenport and the teachers are proud of how hard your students have been working. The Archdiocese of Detroit has assured us that we are not subject to the recent questions on the acceptability of distance learning, and Holy Cross students are on track to finish the year as planned.

Here are a few notes to help distance learning run smoothly:

- Parents: accept teachers' invitations to join Google classrooms (email the school or your teacher if you don't remember having been invited).
- Parents and students: please check your emails several times each day and respond as needed or requested.
- Students: teachers are available for you from 7:30am to 3:30pm each day. Log in and do your work early in the day! Your teacher may not receive your email until the next day if you send it after 3pm.
- Instruction and class work time should take approximately 4 hours each day. If you are having trouble, please let your teacher know right away.
