Archdiocesan Grants

To apply for the Archdiocesan grant: go to your FACTS account and look for "apply for tuition assistance". Application is done online, and there is a small fee. You will also need to print the "Pastor's Signature" page and get your (Archdiocese of Detroit parish) pastor's signature as part of your application. Your application and all supporting paperwork must be complete and submitted by April 30 in order to qualify for a grant.
